## Directions:

The Parade staging area will again be at the western end of Water Street. The Festival will be in the Little Webberville Park and the Stage is at the Old Ferry Landing next to Cook's Canoes. Once at Water Street, follow the Parking signs. **WATER STREET WILL BE CLOSED TO ALL THROUGH TRAFFIC FROM 12:30 to 1:30PM!**

**From Austin**, take MLK / FM 969- 12 miles east of HWY 183 to Downtown Webberville. Look for the Festival signs at Water St. Turn right.

**From Elgin and Bastrop**, take FM 969 three miles west of the Webberville city limit sign. Turn left in Downtown Webberville by the Webberville Grocery Store.
